EDWARD MUNCH 2013

2013. aastal tähistatakse maalikunstnik Edvard Munchi 150. sünniaastapäeva. Munch oli üks esimesi moodsa kujutava kunsti esindajaid ja on säilitanud oma juhtiva rolli tänapäevalgi, kuna tema kunsti peetakse ühtaegu universaalseks ja ajatuks. Munchist on tehtud mitte midle filme, alates informatiivsetest kunstilistest lühifilmidest lõpetades Peter Watkinsi huvitava ja mötlemapaneva eluloofilmiga aastast 1974, mille pealkiri ongi "Edvard Munch". Käesoleval aastal ilmus ka neli uut dokumentaalfilmi: "Päike", "Lase karjel kõlada", "Munchi emad" ja "Näitus ekraanil" 150. sünniaastapäeva tähistamisest Oslos. Huvi-pakkuvaid filme on teisigi, näiteks "Elutants" ja "Näod".

Munch oli ka ise fotograaf ja filmimees ning selles esitluses toome näiteid tema töödest neis valdkondades. Teada-tuntud on, et Munch kirjeldas oma maale ja graafikat sõnadega "See, mida ma nägin", mitte "See, mida ma näen". See juhib mötted kohe filmi ja fotode juurde - need on vahendid, millega on lihtsal moel võimalik kirjeldada sise-mist tunnet või ekspressionistlikult kujustada inimesi ja olukordi. Film ja televisioon on samuti tundud kanalid kunsti esitlemiseks ja visua-liseerimiseks. Edvard Munchist tehtud filmid on mitmekesised nii stiilide kui ka sisu poolest, mis kutsub veelgi rohkem vaatajaid tema näitustele.

2013 marks the 150th anniversary of the painter Edvard Munch's birth. Munch became a pioneer in modern visual art and holds today a leading position, as his art is perceived both universal and timeless. Several films have also been made about the artist, from short informative artistic films to Peter Watkins' interesting and challenging biographical film from 1974 titled "Edvard Munch". This year have also seen four new documentaries, "The Sun", "Let the Scream be Heard", "Munch's Mothers" and "Exhibition on Screen" from the 150 years' celebration in Oslo. There are also other films of interest, like "Dance of Life" and "Faces".

Munch himself was a photographer and filmmaker, and in this presenta-tion we will show examples of his artistic works within these fields. It is well known that Munch described his paintings and graphic art as "What I saw" and not "What I see". This leads immediately to films and photos, media that easily can describe an inner feeling or an expressionistic way of portraying people and situations. Film and television are also well known channels to present and visualize art, and the films about Edvard Munch have a variety in style and content that will draw even more spec-tators to his exhibitions.

Lugu Edvard Munchist, tema elust ja kunstist. Film keskendub olulis-tele sündmustele Munchi elus, mis paljastavad kunstniku olemuse ja selle, kuidas ta elu mõjutas tema kunsti. Film püüab näidata Edvard Munchi mitmekülgust ja dilemmasid ning leida seoseid Munchi kunsti ja täiskasvanuea ning lapsepõlve ja noorusaja vahel. Astume kunstniku jälgedes tema lapsepõlvset kõrge eani.

A film about Edvard Munch, about the life he lived and painted. The film is based upon important events in Munch's life that reveal who he was, and how his art was influenced by the life he lived. The film attempts to capture Edvard Munch's diversity and dilemmas, to find connections between the events of his childhood and youth, his art and his adult life. We follow in his footsteps from childhood to old age.

Sel aastal tähistab Norra Edvard Munchi 150. sünniaastapäeva, mil-lest räägitakse juba kui ainukordsest sündmusest. Huvi maailmas on suur - ja seda mitte ainult seetõttu, et hiljuti müüdi üks neljast "Karje" versioonist avalikul oksjonil rekordilise 120 miljoni dollariga. Oslos asuvad Norra rahvusmuuseum ja Munchi muuseum töid näi-tusel "Munch 150" küllastajate ette 220 maali. Sündmust kajastav film jälgib suurejoonelise näituse kokkupaneku protsessi ja urib süvitsi selle moodsa kunsti silmapaistvaima esindaja elulugu. Näituse giid Tim Marlow vestleb ka erikülastega, kes jagavad oma eksperitarva-musi ja -teadmisi.

This year, all of Norway celebrates the 150th anniversary of the birth of Edvard Munch. This is already being hailed a "once-in-a-lifetime show". Global interest is huge - not least as a result of one of his four versions of "The Scream" having recently set a public art auction record of \$120 million. The exhibition "Munch 150", co-hosted by the National Museum and the Munch Museum, includes 220 paintings. "Exhibition on Screen" shows the process of putting the exhibition together and provides an in-depth biography of one of the towering figures of modern art. Special guests will also offer their expert insight and knowledge to host Tim Marlow.
